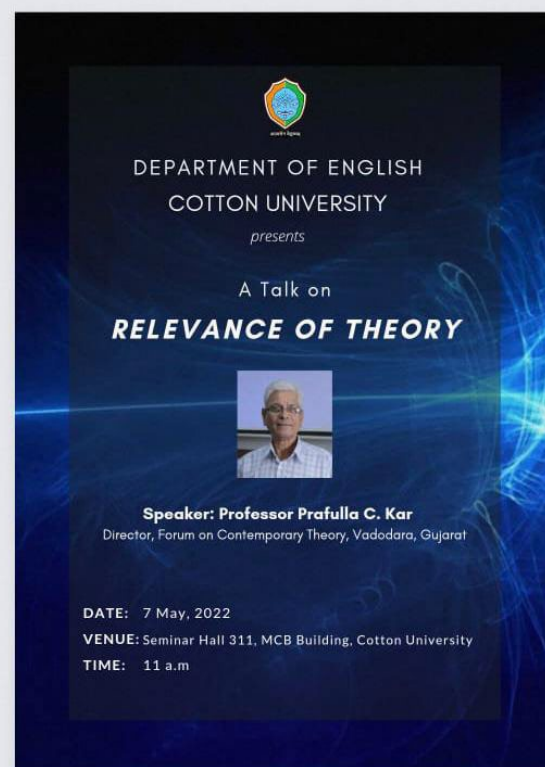


2. Interactive Programme | November 03, 2022

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15. Training and Field Visit | September 15, 2018

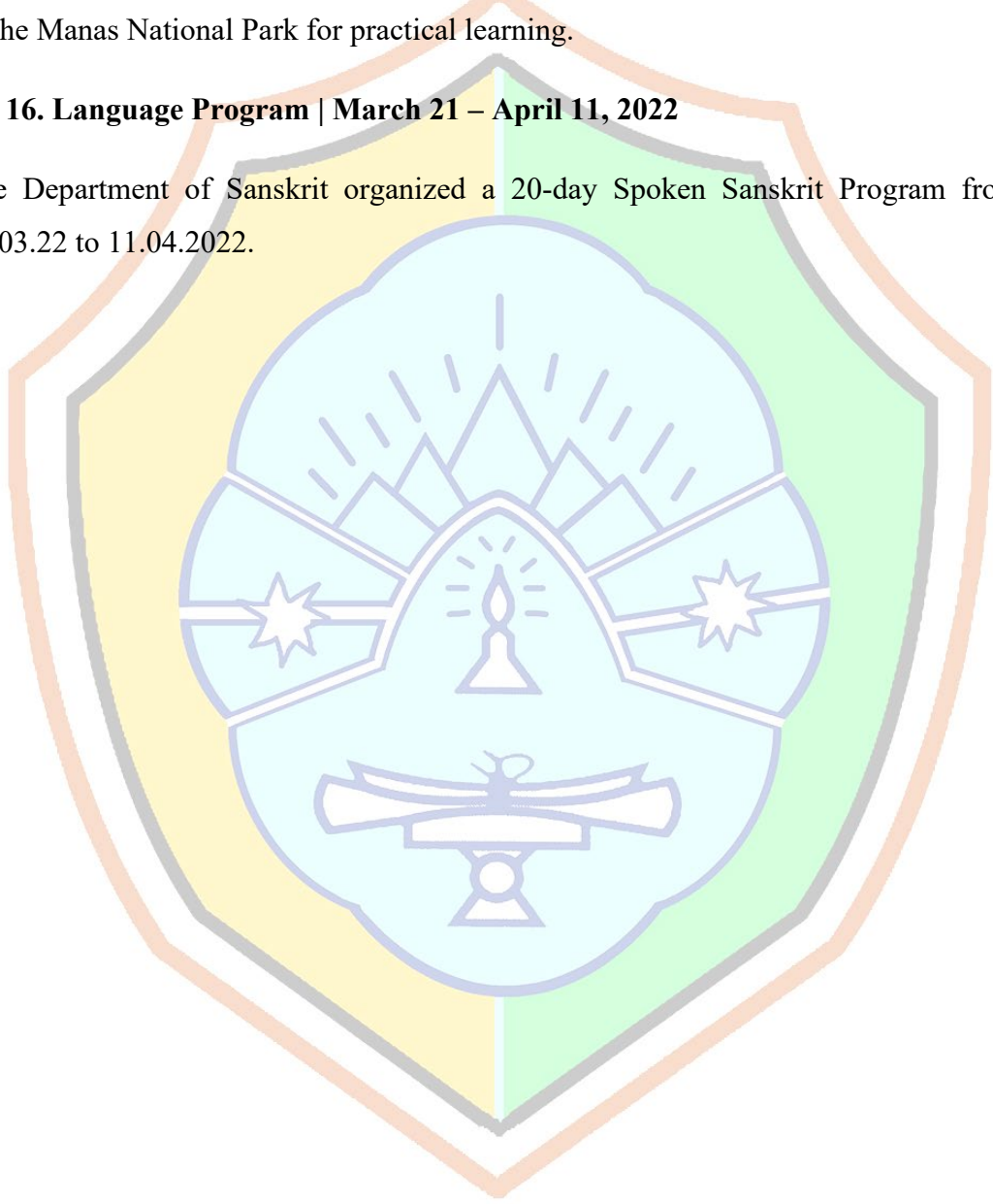
A three-day training and field visit workshop was organised by the Department of Mass Communication, Journalism and Media Studies in association with Aaranyak
